Admission to the study program is governed by Sections 48 to 50 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Other Acts (the Higher Education Act), as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), and Article 4 of the TUL Statutes. The faculty shall publish on its website the deadline and method for submitting applications, the admission conditions, the date and manner of verifying compliance, and, if verification includes an entrance exam requirement, the format and general content of the exam and the criteria for its evaluation.

Admission requirements for all doctoral study programs
The following documents must be submitted with the application.
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Structured CV (including address and contact details), 2. Cover letter, 3. Proposed topic and description of the focus of the dissertation (minimum length 1× A4), 4. Recommendations, especially from a potential supervisor and head of the department (a form can be used), no older than 4 months from the date of submission of the application for study, 5. Confirmation of previous education, 6. List of professional publications, professional scientific and research activities or internships, 7. Valid nostrification of previous education in the case of education abroad, 8. Copy of English language exam at least at level B2, if English is not the official language of the applicant's country of origin



Entrance examination content and assessment criteria for all doctoral study programs.	
Form of the entrance examination	Scientific debate and discussion on the topic of future doctoral thesis.
Point scores	<p>The following will be evaluated during the discussion</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. knowledge obtained during previous studies (0–30 points), 2. the applicant's motivation to study (0–20 points), 3. the quality of the submitted dissertation project (0–35 points), 4. the applicant's scientific research and publishing activities to date (0–15 points).
The maximum score is 100 points.	
Method of ranking applicants for admission	According to the points achieved
Terms and conditions for admission	A minimum score of 50 points and a ranking corresponding to the capacity of the study program.
